

Tragically, on September 20th, Ilyssa lost her battle to heart disease. In her memory, a moment of silence was observed at the golf tournament.

Ilyssa was a fervent advocate for women's heart health awareness, passionately speaking on the topic at NARBW's 2023 convention. Sadly, just three weeks after losing Ilyssa, another cherished NARBW member, Jay Nelson of the Omaha Chapter, succumbed to the same terrible disease.

On October 22nd, together with Ilyssa's husband, son, and the LA Metro Family, NARBW SoCal participated in the American Heart Association LA Heart Walk in honor of both Ilyssa and Jay, raising an impressive \$7,157.11 in under two weeks.
